- Hire extra staff to give the Director more flexibility in programming
- Replace and update children's nonfiction books in Arcadia
- Added three more open hours in Galesville
- Increased spending for collection development
- 3 Libraries in the County recently went fine free for overdue materials
- Host young adult author visits in Osseo
- Host additional book clubs
- Purchase extra tables and chairs in gathering area for homeschool families
- Upgrade library security measures with cameras and quick response call system
